RESOLUTION NO. 45 OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

On motion of Member Karin Freeman, duly seconded and carried, the following Resolution was adopted.

- **WHEREAS**, the District no longer has the financial ability or resources to provide all services which it is currently providing given the current fiscal crisis in the State of California;
- **WHEREAS**, in order to maintain a balanced budget and provide for essential services, the District must eliminate programs and services in the 2011-2012 fiscal year;
- **WHEREAS**, it will be necessary to reduce or discontinue particular kinds of services currently being rendered by certificated personnel for the 2011-2012 fiscal year as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference;
- **WHEREAS**, the reduction or elimination of said services may result in the reassignment and/or lay-off of certificated employees.
- **WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the Superintendent to give notice to employees who may be laid off as a result of reduction in services prior to March 15, 2011.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Superintendent or his designee is hereby directed to give written notice prior to March 15, 2011 to certificated employees pursuant to EC 44949 and 44955 to reduce the number of certificated positions as outlined in Exhibit A.
- **WHEREAS** that employees who first rendered paid service to the District on the same date, be laid off solely on the basis of the needs of the District, as determined by the following tie breaker criteria:
 - 1. One point for CLAD or English Language (EL) authorization.
 - 2. One point for each additional credential authorizing services in more than one area/subject.
 - 3. One point for holding a professional clear (vs. preliminary) teaching credential.
 - 4. One point for each advanced degree (Masters, Doctorate).
- 5. One point for specialty teaching emphasis in Advanced Placement (AP) courses in the 2010-11 school year.
 - 6. One point for specialty teaching emphasis in International Baccalaureate (IB) courses in the 2010-11 school year.
- 7. One point for service at a Program Improvement and/or Title I school within the last two years (2009-10 and 2010-11).
 - 8. One point for service in an extra duty assignment in the 2010-11 school year as defined by Article XIV (F) of the collective bargaining agreement. (Maximum one point possible.)

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Certificated employees who receive a preliminary lay-off notice and who share the same seniority date shall be ranked by total points. If the listed criteria do not break a tie, the District shall hold a lottery at least five working days prior to the layoff hearing. Each group of tied employees shall have the right to attend the lottery and pick a lottery number. In the absence of the employee, the Assistant Superintendent of Personnel Services will select a lottery number on behalf of the employee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent or his designee is authorized and directed to give notices to certificated employees as is necessary to implement this resolution and as required by District Rules and Regulations and applicable provisions of the Education Code of the State of California.
