SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT

- Superintendent Doug Domene thanked the Board for their attendance at last week’s Management Symposium.
- Mr. Joey Davis shared highlights from the Google Apps for Education (GAFE) summit last week at El Dorado High School. Over 175 district staff attended, including certificated and classified employees. The EdTechTeam, based in Irvine, sent a team of five trainers for this two-day training. Material from this training was provided electronically, so that the information can even be shared with those who were not in attendance.
- On Monday and Tuesday, staff from Nutrition Services and the Transportation Department set up shop at the Oberle Gymnasium, located at Melrose Elementary School. Open from 1 to 7 p.m. each day, the teams processed approximately 575 applications for bus passes and free/reduced meals. This number represents one third of all bus passes issued last year.
- There will be several upcoming trainings for PYLUSD employees, including Avid Excel, Campus Supervisors, Special Ed Aides, 504, Nutrition Services, and New Computer Specialists.

**RESOLUTION FOR EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF MASTER GOVERNMENTAL
LEASE-PURCHASE AGREEMENT
PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT**

RESOLUTION NO. 7

WHEREAS, a Resolution of the governing body of Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District, authorizing the execution and delivery of a Master Governmental Lease-Purchase Agreement and Supplement No. 461347-400 thereto with respect to the acquisition purchase, financing and leasing of certain equipment for the public benefit; authorizing the execution and delivery of documents required in connection therewith; and authorizing the taking of all other actions necessary to the consummation of the transactions contemplated by this Resolution.

WHEREAS, Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (the "Lessee"), a body politic and corporate duly organized and existing as a political subdivision, municipal corporation or similar public entity of the State of California is authorized by the laws of the State of California to purchase, acquire and lease personal property for the benefit of the Lessee and its inhabitants and to enter into contracts with respect thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Lessee desires to purchase, acquire and lease certain equipment constituting personal property necessary for the Lessee to perform essential governmental functions; and

WHEREAS, in order to acquire such equipment, the Lessee proposes to enter into the certain Master Governmental Lease-Purchase Agreement (the "Agreement"), and Supplement No. 461347-400 thereto (the "Supplement" and together with the Agreement, the "Lease"), each with Wells Fargo Equipment Finance, Inc. (the "Lessor"), the forms of which have been presented to the governing body of the Lessee at this meeting; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Lessee deems it for the benefit of the Lessee and for the efficient and effective administration thereof to enter into the Supplement as provided in the Agreement for the purchase, acquisition and leasing of the equipment to be therein described on the terms and conditions therein provided:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

Section 1. Approval of Documents. The forms, terms and provisions of the Agreement and Supplement are hereby approved in substantially the forms presented at this meeting. With such insertions, omissions and changes as shall be approved by the Governing Board of the Lessee or other members of the governing body of the Lessee executing the same, the execution of such documents being conclusive evidence of such approval; and the Superintendent of the Lessee is hereby authorized and directed to execute, and the Assistant Superintendent, Business Services of the Lessee is hereby authorized and directed to attest and countersign, the Agreement and the Supplement and any related Exhibits attached thereto and to deliver the Agreement and the Supplement (including such Exhibits) to the respective parties thereto and the Assistant Superintendent, Business Services, of the Lessee is hereby authorized to affix the seal of the Lessee to such documents.

Section 2. Other Actions Authorized, The officers and employees of the Lessee shall take all action necessary or reasonably required by the parties to the Agreement and the Supplement to carry out, give effect to and consummate the transactions contemplated thereby (including the execution and delivery of an acceptance certificate with respect to the Supplement, as contemplated in the Agreement) and to take all action necessary in conformity therewith, including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of any closing and other documents required to be delivered in connection with the Agreement and the Supplement.

Section 3. No General Liability. Nothing contained in this Resolution, the Agreement, the Supplement nor any other instrument shall be construed with respect to the Lessee as incurring a pecuniary liability or charge upon the general credit of the Lessee or against its taxing power, nor shall the breach of any agreement contained in this Resolution, the Agreement, the Supplement or any other instrument or document executed in connection therewith impose any pecuniary liability upon the Lessee or any charge upon its general credit or against its taxing power, except to the extent that the rental payments payable under the Lease are special limited obligations of the Lessee as provided therein.

Section 4. Appointment of Authorized Lessee Representatives. The Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent, Business Services, of the Lessee are each hereby designated to act as authorized representatives of the Lessee for purposes of the Agreement and the Supplement until such time as the governing body of the Lessee shall designate any other or different authorized representative for purposes of the Agreement and the Supplement.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

Section 6. Repealer. All bylaws, orders and resolutions or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. The repealer shall not be construed as reviving any bylaw, order, resolution or ordinance or part thereof.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its approval and adoption.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DEDICATION OF EASEMENT TO
SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON**

WHEREAS, Southern California Edison. ("Company") has previously requested that Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District ("School District") dedicate an easement for electric service ("Easement") upon a portion of the Tuffree Middle School. A legal description and a map depicting the location of the Easement are attached hereto as Exhibit "A" are incorporated by reference herein; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code section 17556, the governing board of a school district may convey to a municipal corporation or political subdivision of the state any real property belonging to such school district; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Section 17557, on July 14, 2015, the School District's governing board, in a regular open meeting, by a two-thirds vote of all its members adopted Resolution No. 3 declaring its intention to dedicate the Easement; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Code Section 17557, the School District's governing board fixed August 18, 2015, for a public hearing ("Public Hearing") upon the question of making the dedication of Easement to Southern California Edison.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17558, the District posted copies of Resolution No. 3 in three public places in the School District not less than ten (10) days before the Public Hearing, and published notice once, not less than five days before the Public Hearing, in a local newspaper; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17558, on August 18, 2015, at a regular meeting of the School District's governing board, the District held a Public Hearing upon the question about making the dedication of the Easement to Southern California Edison.; and

WHEREAS, no petition pursuant to Education Code Section 17560 has been filed with the School District's governing board.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the above recitals are all true and correct.

Section 2. That the Board of the School District hereby determines that the School District is in compliance with all applicable laws, and hereby approves granting of the Easement.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

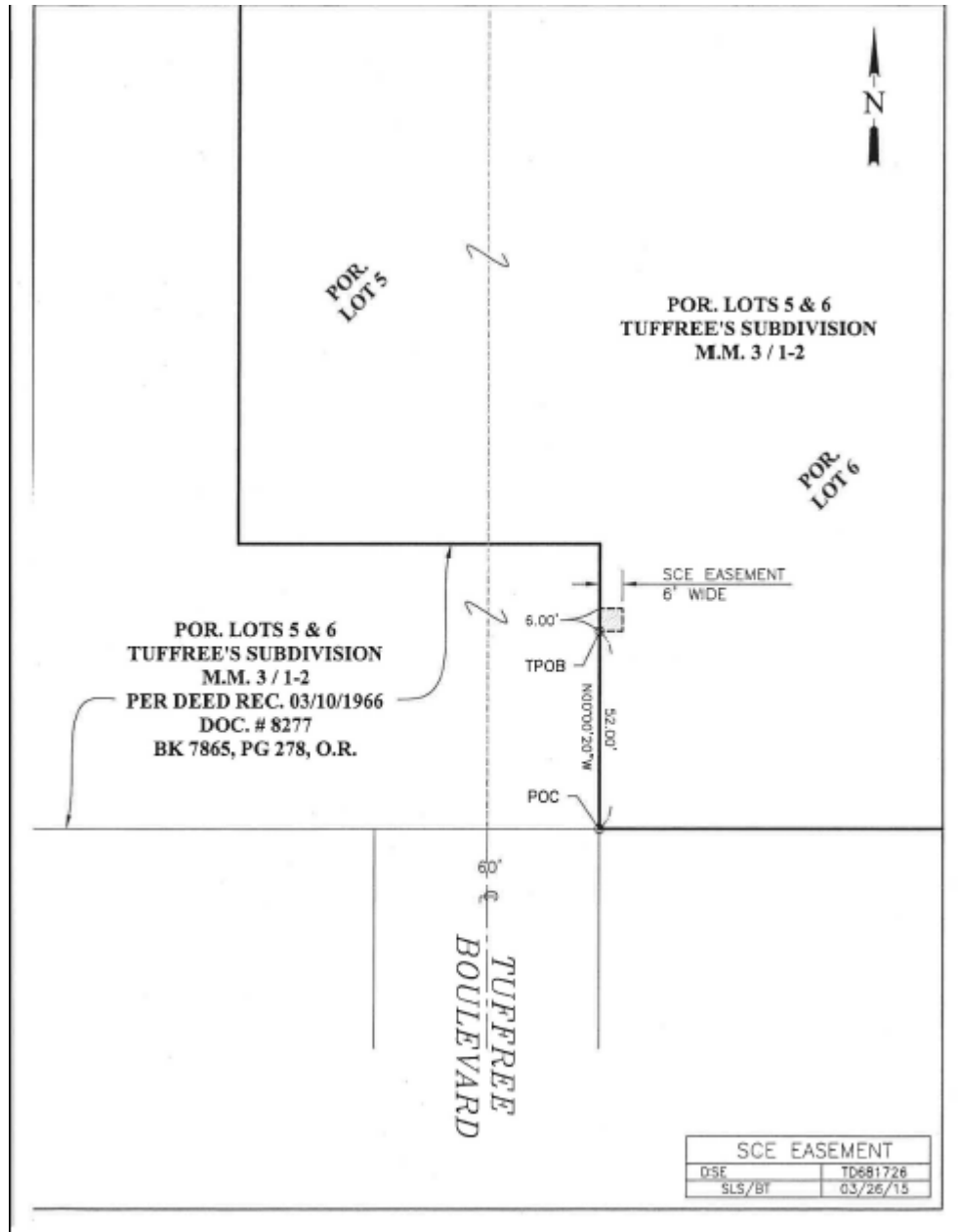

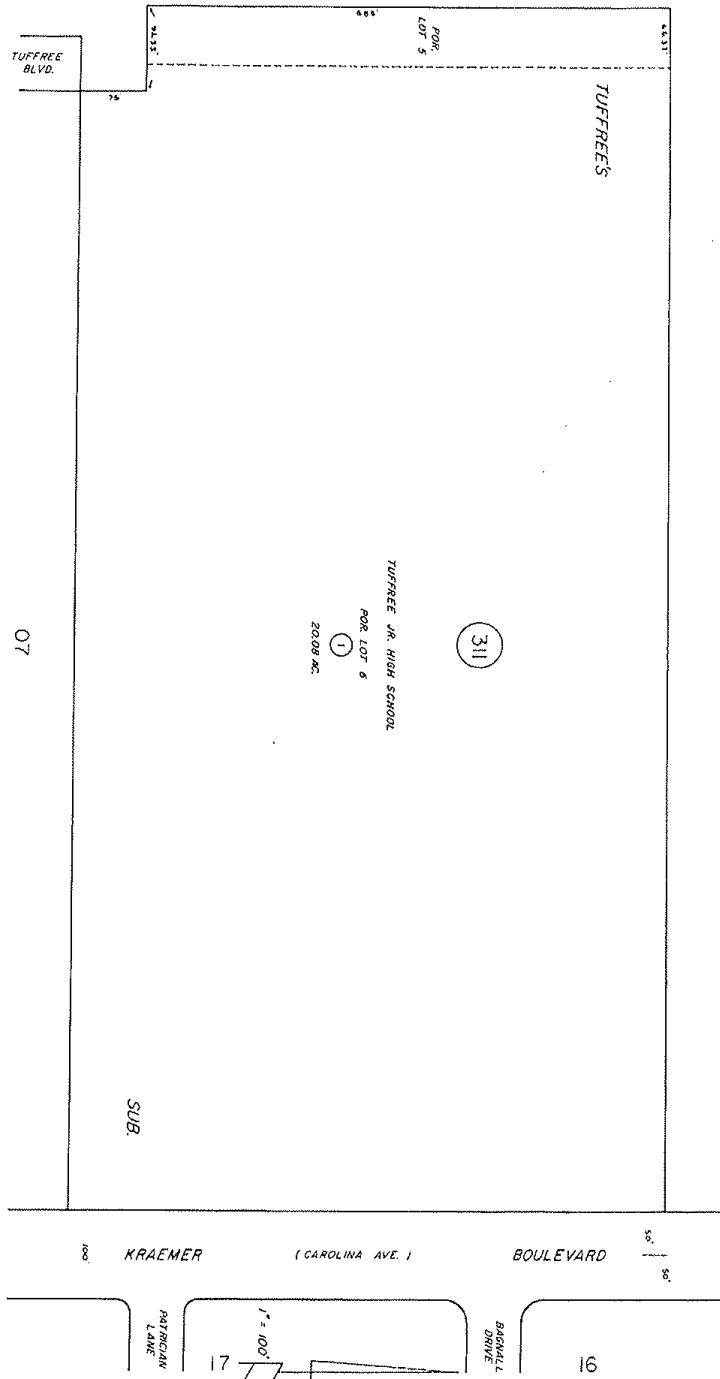
LEGAL DESCRIPTION AND MAP OF THE EASEMENT


