SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Mrs. Minerva Gandara presented a summary of the AVID Program, as well as the training and
 preparation that went into creating this coming year's plan. Five elementary schools, two high
 schools, and five middle schools participated in the AVID summer institutes, titled "Student Success
 Starts Here." Additionally, Kraemer Middle School student Andrea Cervantes will be providing the
 student keynote speech to all conference participants at the AVID Institute in August.
- Mrs. Dorie Staack and Mrs. Minerva Gandara discussed the various summer school programs
 offered by the district, including an English-learner summer camp at Melrose Elementary School.
 This "Fun in the Sun and Under the Sea" ELD camp consisted of 150 students from grades three
 through five who will be focusing on Integrated ELD, art, science and technology.
- Mrs. Dorie Staack then discussed the state legislative changes to transitional kindergarten (Preppy K). Because of the new law, PYLUSD added three new Preppy K sites (Lakeview, Ruby Drive and Sierra Vista) for a total of 22 classes (23 including Parkview School). Educational Services has enrolled 104 students in the last few days, with another 19 families who have expressed interest. An upcoming parent information meeting will be held at 6 p.m. on Thursday, July 16, in the Board Room.
- Dr. Doug Domene highlighted the upcoming Superintendent's Reception on August 12 and Manager's Symposium on August 13. The Symposium, taking place at Yorba Linda High School, will feature service awards, recognition of new managers, individual sessions, and team building activities.

RESOLUTION NO. 2

RESOLUTION FOR THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT ACTING AS THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1 AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING OF SPECIAL TAXES FOR COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (the "Board") has heretofore taken proceedings pursuant to the Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982, as amended, (the "Act") for the establishment of Community Facilities District No. 1 (the "District") for the purpose of providing educational facilities for the use of residents of the District; and

WHEREAS, following a special election of the qualified electors of the District, this Board on November 12, 2002 acting as the governing body of the District, adopted Ordinance No. 1 ("Ordinance") which provided for the levying and collection of Special Taxes within the District, "as provided in the Act and Ordinance and as approved by the qualified electors"; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary and appropriate that this Board levy and collect the Special Taxes for Fiscal Year 2015-2016, by the adoption of a resolution as specified by the Act and Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In accordance with the Act and Ordinance, there is hereby levied upon all properties within the District which are not otherwise exempt from taxation under the Act or Ordinance the special taxes for Fiscal Year 2015-2016 set forth in the Ordinance at the tax rates as set forth therein and in Exhibit "A" hereto, as may be amended without further action of the Board to reflect updated information on assessor's parcel numbers from the County of Orange. The Assistant Superintendent, Fiscal Services, is hereby authorized and directed to establish the final rates to be levied, which final rates shall not exceed the maximum rates.

Section 2. The above-authorized special taxes shall be collected in the same manner as ad valorem property taxes on the secured roll by the Treasurer-Tax Collector of the County of Orange and shall be subject to the same penalties and the same procedure and sale in cases of delinquency as provided for such ad valorem taxes.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Clerk and Assistant Superintendent, Business Services, are hereby authorized to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Orange County Assessor and the Treasurer-Tax Collector, together with other supporting documentation as may be required in order to place said special taxes on the secured property tax roll for the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 and to perform all other acts which are required by the Act, Ordinance or by-law in order to accomplish the purpose of this Resolution.

RESOLUTION NO. 3

OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT GIVING NOTICE OF INTENTION TO GRANT AN EASEMENT (RIGHT OF WAY) TO SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON

WHEREAS, the Yorba Linda Water District ("Water District") has requested that the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District ("School District") dedicate an easement to Southern California Edison upon a portion of the School District's Tuffree Middle School site ("Easement"). A legal description and map depicting the location of the Easement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code section 17556, the governing board of a school district may convey to any public corporation, or private corporation engaged in the public utility business, any real property belonging to such school district upon such terms and conditions as the parties thereto may agree;

WHEREAS, the School District desires to provide an Easement to Southern California Edison for the purposes to construct, use, maintain, operate, alter, add to, repair, replace, reconstruct, inspect and remove at any time and from time to time underground electrical supply systems and communication systems, consisting of wires, underground conduits, cables, vaults, manholes, and including above ground enclosures, markers and concrete pads and other appurtenant fixtures and equipment necessary or useful for distributing electrical energy and for transmitting intelligence by electrical means in, on, over, under, across, and along that certain real property located at Tuffree Middle School.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code section 17557, the School District's governing board must, prior to dedicating an Easement, adopt a resolution declaring its intention to dedicate such Easement in a regular open meeting by two-thirds (2/3) vote of all of its members;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code section 17557, the School District's governing board must fix a time at its regular place of meeting for a public hearing upon the question of making the dedication of the Easement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code section 17558, the School District is required to post copies of this Resolution, signed by the board, in three (3) public places within the School District's boundaries not less than ten (10) days before the public hearing, and publish notice once, not less than five (5) days before the public hearing in a newspaper of general circulation published in the School District, if there is one, or, if there is no such newspaper published in the School District, then in a newspaper published in the county which has a general circulation in the School District.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** That the above recitals are all true and correct.
- <u>Section 2</u>. That the School District's governing board ("Board") declares its intent to dedicate the Easement to Southern California Edison upon the terms and conditions set forth in the recitals.
- **Section 3.** That the Board establishes August 18, 2015 for a public hearing on the question of the School District's intent to dedicate the Easement to Southern California Edison.
- <u>Section 4</u>. The School District staff shall post this resolution in three (3) public places within the School District's boundaries and publish notice of the adoption of this Resolution in compliance with Education Code section 17558.



RELATIONS BETWEEN OTHER GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES AND THE SCHOOLS

The Governing Board recognizes that agencies at all levels of government share its concern and responsibility for the health, safety, and welfare of youth. The Board and Superintendent or designee shall initiate and maintain good working relationships with representatives of these agencies in order to help district schools and students make use of the resources which governmental agencies can provide.

The district may enter into agreements with other agencies which involve the exchange of funds or reciprocal services. Such agreements shall be approved by the Governing Board and executed in writing.

Elections

If a city or county elections official specifically requests the use of a school building as a polling place, the Board shall allow its use for such purpose. The Board may authorize the use of school buildings as polling places on any election day, and may also authorize the use of school buildings, without cost, for the storage of voting machines and other vote-tabulating devices. If school will be in session, the Superintendent or designee shall identify to elections officials the specific areas of the school buildings not occupied by school activities that will be allowed for use as polling places. (Elections Code 12283)

When a school is used as a polling place, the Superintendent or designee shall provide the elections official a site with an adequate amount of space that will allow the precinct board to perform its duties in a manner that will not impede, interfere, or interrupt the normal process of voting and shall make a telephone line for Internet access available for use by local elections officials if so requested. He/she shall make a reasonable effort to ensure that the site is accessible to disabled persons. (Elections Code 12283)
