NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Trustees of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District hereby resolves and declares as follows:

The actual appropriations limit for 2015-2016 was \$153,227,340 and the appropriations did not exceed the limitations imposed by Article XIII B of the California Constitution.

The appropriations limit for 2016-2017 is estimated to be \$160,341,604 and the appropriations do not exceed the limitations imposed by Article XIII B of the California Constitution.

OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT GIVING NOTICE OF INTENTION TO GRANT AN EASEMENT (RIGHT OF WAY) TO CITY OF ANAHEIM

WHEREAS, the City of Anaheim ("City") has requested that the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District ("School District") dedicate an easement to City of Anaheim upon a portion of the School District's Rio Vista Elementary School site ("Easement"). A legal description and map depicting the location of the Easement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B" incorporated herein;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17556, the governing board of a school district may convey to any public corporation, or private corporation engaged in the public utility business, any real property belonging to such school district upon such terms and conditions as the parties thereto may agree;

WHEREAS, the School District desires to provide an Easement to City of Anaheim for public utility and telecommunication purposes to construct, reconstruct, install, replace, reconfigure, operate, maintain, repair, relocate, remove, inspect, observe, and study the equipment, and related appurtenances in, on, over, under, upon, above, along, and across the land in the city of Anaheim on Rio Vista Elementary School;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17557, the School District's governing board must, prior to dedicating an Easement, adopt a resolution declaring its intention to dedicate such Easement in a regular open meeting by two-thirds (2/3) vote of all of its members;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17557, the School District's governing board must fix a time at its regular place of meeting for a public hearing upon the question of making the dedication of the Easement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17558, the School District is required to post copies of this Resolution, signed by the board, in three (3) public places within the School District's boundaries not less than ten (10) days before the public hearing, and publish notice once, not less than five (5) days before the public hearing in a newspaper of general circulation published in the School District, if there is one, or, if there is no such newspaper published in the School District, then in a newspaper published in the county which has a general circulation in the School District.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** That the above recitals are all true and correct.
- **Section 2.** That the School District's governing board ("Board") declares its intent to dedicate the Easement to City of Anaheim upon the terms and conditions set forth in the recitals.
- <u>Section 3.</u> That the Board establishes September 13, 2016 for a public hearing on the question of the School District's intent to dedicate the Easement to City of Anaheim.
- <u>Section 4.</u> The School District staff shall post this resolution in three (3) public places within the School District's boundaries and publish notice of the adoption of this Resolution in compliance with Education Code Section 17558.



WHEREAS, the hearing shall be held at a time that will encourage the attendance of teachers and parents and guardians of pupils who attend the schools in the district and shall not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

WHEREAS, the governing Board of a school district, as part of the required hearing, shall also make a written determination as to whether each pupil enrolled in a foreign language or health course has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the state board for those subjects, and;

WHEREAS, the governing Board shall also determine the availability of laboratory science equipment as applicable to science laboratory courses offered in Grades 9 – 12, inclusive, and;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on September 13, 2016 and;

WHEREAS, the Board is required to make a determination as to whether each pupil in each school in the district has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each of the following subjects, as appropriate, that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board:

- (i) Mathematics
- (ii) Science
- (iii) History-social science
- (iv) English/language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program
- (v) Visual and performing arts

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NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the governing Board makes the determination that each pupil of the district, has available sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each subject listed above, consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board and adopted by this Board in accordance with the procedures as established.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the 2016 – 2017 school year, the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District will provide each pupil with sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each subject listed above, consistent with the content and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board for those subjects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the 2016 – 2017 school year, the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District will provide sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the State Board, to each pupil enrolled in a foreign language or health course and that sufficient laboratory science equipment applicable to science laboratory courses offered in Grades 9 – 12, inclusive, is available to pupils.

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BOARD POLICY

Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District

Students 5141.3 - BP

IMMUNIZATIONS

In recognition of the fact that prevention is a means of combating the spread of disease, it shall be the policy of the Board of Education to require that all students be immunized against certain diseases in order to safeguard the community. Immunizations shall be in accordance with state statutes unless specifically exempted by law.

All students under the age of 18 entering the schools of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District must present an immunization record from any authorized private or public health care provider certifying that the student has been immunized against diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus, poliomyelitis, measles, mumps, rubella, varicella, Haemophilus influenzae type b (Pre-school only), Hepatitis B (Transitional K/Kindergarten only), and any other disease designated by the California Department of Public Health.

The board shall excuse from immunization requirements a student whose parent presents written documentation from a physician that the student is medically exempt. Any personal belief exemptions filed at a school prior to January 2016 will remain valid until the student enrolls in the next grade span at either Transitional Kindergarten/Kindergarten, or 7th grade.

The Superintendent or designee shall immediately enroll homeless students, foster youth, and students of military families even if their immunization records are missing or unavailable at the time of enrollment. School or district staff shall work with the student's prior school to obtain the student's immunization records or shall ensure that he/she is properly immunized.

The exemptions to the immunization requirements will be authorized with the understanding that if there is an outbreak of any communicable disease that falls under the immunization requirements the student may be excluded from school for a period of time to be determined by the superintendent or his designee in consultation with the Orange County Health Care Agency until the possibility of communicability has passed.

WHEREAS Leadership Matters for California's public education system and the more than 6 million students it serves;

WHEREAS, School administrators are passionate, lifelong learners who believe in the value of quality public education, and

WHEREAS, The title "school administrator" is a broad term used to define many education leadership posts. Superintendents, assistant superintendents, principals, assistant principals, special education and adult education leaders, curriculum and assessment leaders, school business officials, classified educational leaders, and other school district employees are considered administrators; and

WHEREAS, providing quality service for student success is paramount for the profession; and

- **WHEREAS**, Most school administrators began their careers as teachers. The average administrator has served in public education for more than a decade. - **WHEREAS**, Public schools operate with lean management systems. - **WHEREAS**, School leaders depend on a network of support from school communities fellow administrators, teachers, parents, students, businesses, community members, board trustees, colleges and universities, community and faith-based organizations, elected officials and district and county staff and resources to promote ongoing student achievement and school success; and
- **WHEREAS**, Research shows great schools are led by great principals, and great districts are led by great superintendents. These site leaders are supported by extensive administrative networks throughout the state; and

- **WHEREAS**, the reduction or elimination of said services may result in the reassignment and/or lay-off of classified employees.
- **WHEREAS**, the reduction or elimination of said services may result in the lack of work or expiration of a specially funded program.
- **WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the Superintendent to give notice to employees who will be laid off as a result lack of funds or of elimination of services 60 days prior to the effective date of layoff.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Superintendent or his designee is hereby directed to give written notice to employees pursuant to EC45117, EC45298 and ED45308 in accordance with any agreement between the district and the association.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Notice of Layoff be given in accordance with the appropriate provisions of the California Education Code and any agreement between the District and classified employees.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Superintendent or his designee is authorized and directed to give notices to classified employees as is necessary to implement this resolution and as required by District Rules and Regulations and applicable provisions of the Education Code of the State of California.
