PUBLIC COMMENT

CSEA Union President Job Suarez presented the Board of Education with a plaque in recognition of the district's participation in CSEA's Appreciating Classified Employee (ACE) Program.

Neel Schmitt addressed the Board of Education with information regarding Veterans' Day 2018 as well as community emergency response team training.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Superintendent Plutko stated that it is evident we are full speed ahead to the start of school with the beginning of student registrations. District managers were welcomed back with a productive Leadership Symposium on Thursday. Dr. Plutko thanked Maintenance and Facilities Executive Director Rick Guaderrama for the great work his team has done during the summer. He also thanked Technology Director Jeremy Powell and his team for their proactive efforts to ensure the student information system and registrations are ready to go.
- Dr. Plutko shared that the Board has given clear direction on the importance of wellness. He invited Director of Innovation and Technology Cary Johnson to speak on where we are with return to learn and concussion protocols, the ability to pretest our athletes, and the importance of having a baseline test. At the conclusion of the presentation, the superintendent commented that the work that Mr. Johnson and Executive Director of Instructional Support Mr. McAlindin have done on this topic is greatly appreciated.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT (Continued)

Lastly, one item that is a part of the landscape in K-12 districts in south Orange County is the California Healthy Youth Act, which addresses the process of sex education for our students. Dr. Plutko advised there is a great amount of misinformation being shared through social media and the Internet around what schools will be or will not be doing with this. Legislation was implemented in 2016, so we have already been in the process of working with this. The concern seems to be the choice of curriculum being used. We are preparing a letter that will be going to all of our parents. Our most important part of this is to make sure that the information we get out to our community is accurate. In our district, the education on this subject is done in seventh and ninth grade through health and/or physical education classes, and that is, at this point, not changing for us. The adoption of new materials is not until 2021. We will reach out heavily to our stakeholders to make sure they have input and real opportunities to view materials. In the interim, they need to know that we are not doing anything different. The letter will be part one of the process and part two will be a formal presentation to the Board at our September meeting. With all of that out there, we are paying close attention and are also being proactive as well.

RESOLUTION NO. 3 AUGUST 14, 2018

CONSTITUTION DAY EDUCATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS this day will be known as "Constitution Day" to honor the signing of the Constitution on September 17, 1787, and

WHEREAS the Federal legislation authorizing this Day states, "Each educational institution that receives Federal funds for a fiscal year should hold an educational program on the United States Constitution on September 17 of such year for the students served by the educational institution," and

WHEREAS should September 17 fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or Holiday, educational institutions should celebrate "Constitution Day" the preceding or the following week, and

WHEREAS the 2005 federal spending bill requires all educational institutions, including colleges and universities, which receive federal funds from any agency to have programming for "Constitution Day," and

ADMISSION

Age of Admission to Kindergarten

Initial admission to kindergarten shall be determined solely on the basis of chronological age as outlined in the Education Code. As amended by the Kindergarten Readiness Act of 2010, children are eligible for kindergarten enrollment if their fifth birthday is on or before September 1.

Age of Admission to Transitional Kindergarten (Preppy K)

The district's Transitional Kindergarten (Preppy K) program shall admit children whose fifth birthday is on or after September 2 through December 2. Children admitted to Transitional Kindergarten (Preppy K) are required to be toilet trained, unless the child has a disability documented in an Individualized Education Plan (IEP).

Age of Admission to Expanded Transitional Kindergarten (Preppy K)

As amended by Education Code 48000 (c)(3)(B), children are eligible to enroll in Expanded Transitional Kindergarten (Preppy K) classes on a space-available basis. The amendment allows districts the option of admitting any child who will have his/her fifth birthday after December 2 but during that same school year. Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District will accept children in Expanded Transitional Kindergarten (Preppy K) who turn five on or after December 3 through March 31 based on space availability. Children who enter as Expanded Transitional Kindergarteners may attend from the beginning of the school year and will generate ADA when they attain the age of five. Children admitted to Expanded Transitional Kindergarten (Preppy K) are required to be toilet trained, unless the child has a disability documented in an Individualized Education Plan (IEP).

Other Admissions

Admission of children to other grades shall involve a consideration of both chronological age and the readiness of the children to do the work required at each grade level.
