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#### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Greg Plutko commented how quickly the summer is moving, and we have a lot of
work being done across our campuses, including painting, flooring, fencing, as well as updating our
technology infrastructure and even implementing our new front office system for the safety and
wellness of our students.

- Dr. Plutko shared that Technology Director Jeremy Powell indicated that the cabling for the camera systems at our four comprehensive high schools should be done in about a week. The next step will be the installation and, combined with fencing work, we continue to be proud of the safety and wellness opportunities we are providing all our schools.
- Continuing on the safety and wellness topic, on agenda for consideration of the Board is an action item with a company by the name of ImPACT Applications, which provides "return to learn" protocols with baseline concussion testing for our student-athletes. This allows us to set a benchmark for wellness so that if there is an injury to them later, a baseline test will be available for comparison. This connects to the Wellness Committee work led by Deputy Superintendent Candy Plahy. We received a nice compliment for Director of Special Education Renee Gray, Mrs. Plahy, and their teams as we are considering Registered Behavior Technicians (RBTs) at the elementary level to help with some of the unique behaviors we are finding. Dr. Plutko thanked and congratulated our team for this leading-edge work.
- As you are aware, we have a partnership through a funding grant with the City of Anaheim to install
  a solar parking structure at Esperanza High School. We are full-speed ahead and on target to be
  done by the time school begins.

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#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2**

RESOLUTION FOR THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT ACTING AS THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1 AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING OF SPECIAL TAXES FOR COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1

**WHEREAS,** the Board of Education of Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (the "Board") has heretofore taken proceedings pursuant to the Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982, as amended, (the "Act") for the establishment of Community Facilities District No. 1 (the "District") for the purpose of providing educational facilities for the use of residents of the District; and

WHEREAS, following a special election of the qualified electors of the District, this Board on November 12, 2002 acting as the governing body of the District, adopted Ordinance No. 1 ("Ordinance") which provided for the levying and collection of Special Taxes within the District, "as provided in the Act and Ordinance and as approved by the qualified electors," and

**WHEREAS**, it is now necessary and appropriate that this Board levy and collect the Special Taxes for Fiscal Year 2018-19 by the adoption of a resolution as specified by the Act and Ordinance;

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In accordance with the Act and Ordinance, there is hereby levied upon all properties within the District which are not otherwise exempt from taxation under the Act or Ordinance the special taxes for Fiscal Year 2018-19 set forth in the Ordinance at the tax rates as set forth therein and in Exhibit "A" hereto, as may be amended without further action of the Board to reflect updated information on assessor's parcel numbers from the County of Orange. The Assistant Superintendent, Business Services, is hereby authorized and directed to establish the final rates to be levied, which final rates shall not exceed the maximum rates.

<u>Section 2.</u> The above-authorized special taxes shall be collected in the same manner as ad valorem property taxes on the secured roll by the Treasurer-Tax Collector of the County of Orange and shall be subject to the same penalties and the same procedure and sale in cases of delinquency as provided for such ad valorem taxes.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Clerk and Assistant Superintendent, Business Services, are hereby authorized to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Orange County Assessor and the Treasurer-Tax Collector, together with other supporting documentation as may be required in order to place said special taxes on the secured property tax roll for the Fiscal Year 2018-19 and to perform all other acts which are required by the Act, Ordinance, or by-law in order to accomplish the purpose of this Resolution.

<u>Students</u> 5145.13 - BP

#### STUDENT IMMIGRATION STATUS

The Governing Board is committed to the success of all students and believes that every school site should be a safe and welcoming place for all students and their families irrespective of their citizenship or immigration status.

District staff shall not solicit or collect information or documents regarding the citizenship or immigration status of students or their family members or provide assistance with immigration enforcement at district schools, except as may be required by state and federal law.

No student shall be denied equal rights and opportunities nor be subjected to unlawful discrimination, harassment, intimidation, or bullying in the District's programs and activities on the basis of his/her immigration status.

The Superintendent or designee shall notify parents/guardians regarding their children's right to a free public education regardless of immigration status or religious beliefs and their rights related to immigration enforcement.

Consistent with requirements of the California Office of the Attorney General, the Superintendent or designee shall develop procedures for addressing any requests by a law enforcement officer for access to district records, school sites, or students for the purpose of immigration enforcement.

The Superintendent or designee shall report to the Board in a timely manner any requests for information or access to a school site by an officer or employee of a law enforcement agency for the purpose of enforcing the immigration laws. Such notification shall be provided in a manner that ensures the confidentiality and privacy of any potentially identifying information.
