BOARD REPORT

Mr. Shawn Youngblood stated that he had nothing to report.

Mrs. Marilyn Anderson opened her report by welcoming our new Superintendent, Dr. James Elsasser, and commenting how she appreciates his work ethic, follow-through, and sense of humor. In December, she had the privilege to watch El Dorado's virtual "Tinsel" choir program. She also met with the Assistant Superintendent of Business for a course in school budgeting and participated in the virtual Dual Language Academy (DLA) night. As a reminder, applications for DLA are due by January 29. Mrs. Anderson also mentioned that applications for the CareerLink Pathways are available online. She enjoyed touring Yorba Linda High School, Bernardo Yorba Middle, and Bryant Ranch Elementary schools and viewing the PPE modifications done to keep students and staff safe. Mrs. Anderson stated that she is looking forward to the webinar on the new governor's budget proposal. She encouraged families to attend the LCAP Virtual Town Meeting on February 2 as it is a great opportunity for the community to learn more and give input. Lastly, Mrs. Anderson informed the community that the Trustees get everything that is submitted to them in public comments. She said that she appreciates all of the concerns, questions, and ideas for improvement.

Mrs. Carrie Buck mentioned that she viewed El Dorado's virtual Tinsel choir program and appreciated the clear masks the student participants wore so you could see their smiling, singing, beautiful faces. She was able to virtually tour the new wellness mental health facility, as well as virtually attend the CSBA meeting on the governor's budget. She also looks forward to hearing more about the early research and data for opening schools. In conclusion, Mrs. Buck shared that she appreciates feedback, concerns, and comments from the community and reads each one to stay informed. She stated she will work collaboratively with all Board members to ensure quality educational programs in a positive climate for all students to succeed now and in the future.

Mrs. Leandra Blades stated that she ran for the Board of Education on transparency and would like the Board to consider livestreaming the meetings. She had some questions about the mandatory COVID testing and mentioned that our district has the best personal protective equipment (PPE). She wanted the Board to consider creating a school board advisory committee. Finally, she mentioned that she campaigned on opening school and believes that the mental health of our students is important and we need to work hard to get them back in school.

Mrs. Karin Freeman opened by thanking so many of our community members for reaching out with their opinions. She reads all correspondence that she receives and said it is a good indicator of the perspectives of those in our community. As the district's representative for ROP, Mrs. Freeman gave an update on the ROP meeting she attended virtually. In addition, she is part of the Orange County Committee on School District Organization and provided an update on their work as well as a handout that shows all the OC school districts and community colleges and whether they hold school board elections by-trustee or at-large. She shared that only 50% of children have used preventative services this past year through the St. Jude Medical Center. Mrs. Freeman offered thanks to the Nutrition Services team for the continued planning and providing meals to our students, our school nurses for all their hard work in monitoring COVID cases, and Business Services for their diligent work on the audit. Lastly, she welcomed Jackson as the new student board member.

Authorization to Apply for and Secure Grant Funding from the South Coast Air Quality Management District PA No. 2021-02 AB 923 School Bus Replacement Program

Whereas, the Board of Trustees of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District of Orange County, State of California, has determined the District's transportation needs; and

Whereas, the District needs to replace twenty-one school buses under PA No. 2021-02 released by the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) announced at their October 2, 2020 board meeting. Awards will be announced at the SCAQMD board meeting on April 2, 2021.

Whereas, this grant is for replacement of pre-2001 model year school buses. Any match funding required by the Lower-Emission School Bus Program Guidelines will be provided by the SCAQMD on behalf of the participant up to the maximum funding amounts. The Board of Trustees by this resolution is also showing that they are fully committed to obtaining these grants and following through with all of the requirements of this grant program.

Whereas, the school match requirement would be above SCAQMD's maximum funding amount.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Board of Trustees of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District does hereby authorize the school district's Superintendent to apply for and secure all possible funding for the replacement of twenty-one school buses with a commitment by this Board through this resolution to pay all school match money required, and additional option costs, on any buses granted through the SCAQMD AB 923 program, PA No. 2021-02.
